**An Act relating to The Lottery**

*Assented on the # of January, 2024*

SARHOLM, 2024



**BE IT ENACTED**, by the Office of the Prime Minister of the New Sarovian Empire and Her Colonies and Dominions, with the advice and consent of the Imperial Parliament thereof, as follows:

### **Introduction**

In accordance with the Immigration Act of 2022, Baroness Teri of the Hats Party proposes that a Sarovia Lotto Company and Monopoly be granted to upstanding Sarovian citizens. The law when it receives imperial approval will be given 24 hours for candidates to own this company.

This monopoly can be attained by messaging the Prime Minister or other. The Prime Minister will appoint 2 of the candidates to be the leader of the Sarovia Lotto Company.

### **Terms of Monopoly**

These two people will be given a monopoly by the government to form a lottery company. They must host 1 lottery event every two weeks at a minimum, Failure to do so will cause a warning and 5 warnings in a row will result in the monopoly being revoked for the individual who owns the lottery monopoly. The lottery company can focus around lotteries, trivia for money, racing and other gambling activity.

### **Legal obligations**

#### **Trivia rules**

Those running the lottery trivia segments cannot provide answers to trivia questions, trivia funds must be provided by the individual hosting to avoid fraud.

If caught they are to be stripped of all there lottery monopolies and fined the prized amount.

#### **Lottery rules**

The individuals hosting the lottery cannot participate themselves and must record the selection process of the winners or select the winner in a public way.

Failure to secure the fairness of the lottery will result in the removal of all lottery monopolies and fined the prized amount.

#### **Other**

This only covers two forms of lotto but fairness should be maintained with all games, failure to ensure fairness will result in the consequences provided prior.
