An Act to Incentivize Immigration to Philippia

Assented to on the #th of Month, Year

RACHAELSBURG, 2024



BE IT ENACTED, by the Office of the Prime Minister of the Dominion of Philippia, with the advice and consent of the Philippian Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short Title

1. This act may be cited as the “Immigration Incentives Act”

Definitions

2. The following terminology are defined as follows:
 - (a) “Immigrant” is any individual seeking residency in the Dominion of Philippia.
 - (b) “Sponsor” is any individual who assists an immigrant in migrating to the Dominion of Philippia.
 - (c) “Commonwealth Immigrant” is an immigrant from within the Sarovian Commonwealth.
 - (d) “Foreign Immigrant” is an immigrant from outside the Sarovian Commonwealth.

Incentive

3. The following incentives will be provided to immigrants and sponsors as follows:
 - (a) 1,000 Liras each for commonwealth immigrants and sponsors if the immigrant remains for a minimum of 1 week as a citizen.
 - (b) 1,000 Liras each for commonwealth immigrants and sponsors if the immigrant remains for a minimum of 2 weeks as publicly employed.
 - (c) 3,000 Liras each for foreign immigrants and sponsors if the immigrant remains for a minimum of 1 week as a citizen.
 - (d) 3,000 Liras each for foreign immigrants and sponsors if the immigrant remains for a minimum of 2 weeks as publicly employed.
 - (e) 100 Robux for sponsors that assist in the immigration of 10 immigrants qualified for incentives under section 3B and 3D

Sponsor Qualifications

3. A sponsor must meet the following requirements to qualify for incentives:
 - (a) Is a Philippian citizen
 - (b) Has a clean criminal record

Immigrant Qualifications

4. An immigrant must meet the following requirements to qualify for incentives:
 - (a) Has a clean criminal record
 - (b) Eligible for citizenship
 - (c) Background check performed

Incentive Variability

5. All incentives are subject to variability plus or minus the amounts given in section 3. Alternatives may be offered in cases where there is no availability of funds.

Fraud

6. Individuals who commit fraud in order to receive incentives shall receive a minimum fine of 5,000 liras or a minimum labor sentence of 15 minutes.
