An act to provide a path toward citizenship, to ensure the proper defence of our culture and democracy and responsible management of migration, and for other related purposes

Assented to on the Xth of August, 2024

BE IT ENACTED, by the Office of the Prime Minister of the Dominion of Philippia, with the advice and consent of the Philippian Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short Title

1. This act may be cited as the “Citizenship and Immigration Act”.

Separation of New Sarovian and Philippian Citizenship

2. Citizenship in the Dominion of Philippia shall be separate from the citizenship of the New Sarovian Empire. All current Sarovian citizens holding residency in Philippia may continue to be citizens of the Dominion of Philippia.

Loyalty to the Crown

4. All residents who desire to receive citizenship must swear an oath or affirmation of allegiance to the Crown in-game witnessed by any Judge, Peer or Member of Parliament.

The oath shall be as follows:

I, (Name), do swear that I will be faithful and bear true allegiance to His Imperial Majesty Carolus XIII, King of Philippia and Emperor of the Sarovian Commonwealth and His Heirs and Successors, and that I will faithfully observe the laws of the Empire; so help me Stefan.

The affirmation shall be as follows:

I, (Name), do solemnly affirm that I will be faithful and bear true allegiance to His Imperial Majesty Carolus XIII, King of Philippia and Emperor of the Sarovian Commonwealth and His Heirs and Successors, and that I will faithfully observe the laws of the Empire.

Power to Grant and Revoke Citizenship

4. Citizenship may be granted or revoked at the will of His Royal Majesty’s Government with reasons not needed to be disclosed.

Residency Requirement

4. No individual may be granted citizenship by His Royal Majesty's Government without at least holding residency in Philippia for—

- (a) a minimum of 3 months,
- (b) a minimum of 1 month with a written endorsement by a member of the Philippian Peerage,
- (c) a minimum of 1 week with Sarovian citizenship and a written endorsement by a member of the Sarovian Peerage,
- (d) or a minimum 1 week through marriage to a Philippian citizen recognized by the Stefanic church and determination that the marriage was entered in good faith.

Educational Requirement

4. All residents who desire to receive citizenship must pass a history test and a civics test as prescribed by His Royal Majesty's Government. This requirement may be waived for any individual who holds a degree in any educational institution recognized within the Commonwealth.

Moral Requirement

4. No individual may receive citizenship if they have previously been convicted or admitted to have been convicted of crime without a waiver by His Royal Majesty's Government.

Social Requirements

4. All residents who desire to receive citizenship must provide a first name, surname, and demographic background as required by His Royal Majesty's Government.

Unproductive Citizens

4. An unproductive citizen is any citizen that does not provide cultural, economic, social, military, or political value to the Dominion of Philippia as determined by the government of the Dominion of Philippia. Philippian citizens designated as unproductive by His Royal Majesty's Government may have their citizenship revoked.

Children of Philippian Citizens

4. No special considerations should be made for children of Philippian citizens in regards to obtaining citizenship. All children of Philippian citizens shall meet the same requirements and undergo the same processes as immigrants seeking to acquire citizenship to obtain citizenship.

Timely Obtainment of Requirements

4. Residents beginning their process to obtain citizenship must finish all requirements within 1 month.

Deportation of Threats

4. Individuals—

- (a) determined to have or have a history of behaviour associated with a medical disorder or disease that may pose a threat to safety and peace of the Dominion of Philippia,
- (b) who commit or have a history of committing crimes to further ideological goals or are associated to groups or individuals who commit or have a history of committing crimes to further ideological goals,
- (c) who have been previously deported and have re-entered under a false identity,
—may be deported by His Royal Majesty's Government.
