An Act relating to Emergency Powers of the Government and Contingencies

Assented to on the Xth of August, 2024

E IT ENACTED, by the Office of the Prime Minister of the Dominion of

Philippia, with the advice and consent of the Philippian Parliament thereof, as

follows:

Short Title

1. This act may be cited as the "Emergency Powers Act".

Repealment Domestic Military Security Authorization Act

2. Upon assent of this bill, the Domestic Military Security Authorization Act of 2024 will be considered nullified in its entirety.

Military Law Enforcement Authority

3. Any and all military forces under the control of the government of the Dominion of Philippia or present in Philippia under the control of the government of New Sarovia may conduct law enforcement operations as required which may include arrests, detainments, and other actions deemed necessary for the maintenance of law and order at the orders of His Royal Majesty's Government.

State of Emergency

4. A state of emergency may be declared by the Prime Minister or the Crown in circumstances deemed a threat to the security, stability or public order in the Dominion of Philippia. Under a state of emergency, the Government may enforce special emergency measures deemed to be necessary by the Government to address the emergency. A state of emergency may last indefinitely and may be terminated by the Royal Parliament by majority vote or unilaterally by the Prime Minister or the Crown at any moment.

Martial Law

5. His Royal Majesty's Government may form a subordinate military government headed by a military governor, a military officer appointed to serve as head of the military government, to have authority either in the Dominion of Philippia as a whole or in a specifically defined region during a state of emergency. Under martial law, the military may assume control of public order and security and may try civilians under court-martial and the military government may assume control of government services. Martial law may be terminated by the Royal Parliament by majority vote or unilaterally by the Prime Minister or the Crown at any moment.
