E IT ENACTED, by the Office of the Prime Minister of the New Sarovian Empire and Her Colonies and Dominions, with the advice and consent of the Imperial Parliament thereof, as follows:

Introduction

1. Whereas the Currency Act of 2020 was passed, the Imperial Parliament is in need of levying taxes in order to pay for the events, salaries and training necessary and befitting of the great state of the New Sarovian Empire. His Imperial Majesty's Government proposes the establishment of five taxes - each that can be adjusted by a vote of Parliament.

The first tax to be established by HIM Government is the income tax, which is a set value and not based on percentage but divided between higher class status and lower class status Sarovians. This is often interpreted as the division between officer and enlisted, but also includes the civil service and cabinet ministers.

The second tax to be established by HIM Government is the corporate tax, which is a percentage based on all profit the company had made in the month. Since every company has its own bank account with the SIBC, whatever percentage deemed appropriate by the Parliament will be taken from their monthly profit.

The third tax to be established by HIM Government is the property tax, which is a set value and not based on percentage, but much like the income tax, is divided between higher class status and lower class status Sarovians. This is often interpreted as the division between officer and enlisted, but also includes the civil service and cabinet ministers. The tax is taken per property - so should someone own two properties, the tax will be doubled for their level.

The fourth tax to be established by HIM Government is the AFK tax, which is a universal set value which is not based on percentage but is not divided per status. For every time a member of the Empire is caught going AFK for longer than five minutes, they will be taxed the universal rate.

The fifth and final tax established by the Taxes Act is the social tax, which is a universal set value which is not based on percentage but also not divided by status. The social tax is intended to incentivize individuals to follow along with social norms that are deemed valuable in Sarovia, such as Stefanic values, human heads, failure to comply with social conventions regarding names, and more. It is set by Parliament and approved by HIM the Emperor.
