An Act to Reform and Clean Up the State of the New Sarovian
Empire.

- 1. Introduction** With the conclusion of the Second Great War and the victory of the New Sarovian Empire over the Free States, it is time to move forward from solely focusing on war, and shift back to our focus on internal development. In doing so, however, the Empire must clean up the muddy bureaucracy that has fallen upon it due to the neglect of much of the government during the war. Therefore, I now propose this Act, which contains a five-step cleanup process.
- 2. Ministerial Reform** Ensure all Ministers are doing their jobs and that each of the non-Crown-held Ministry spots are full. Employ new ministers and shuffle people around if necessary. Ensure the reactivation of the Carolus Graal YouTube channel and its renaming to “New Sarovian Empire”, and move New Sarovia Today to that channel, to be presented in video format, among other things. Specifically pertaining to the Secretary to the Crown, that secretary should be by the Emperor’s side whenever he is needed. And should be delivering frequent reports to the Emperor. Conduct weekly Riksdag meetings every Thursday at 9:00 PM EST. Abolish political parties and add a Chancellor; and hold new elections for Prime Minister; and amend the Constitution with the following new election procedure:
 - a) Hold a public meeting on a Friday in Tre Kronor’s meeting hall where people may declare candidacy for Chancellor. Compilation of an official candidate registry and selection by the Emperor of Election Commissioners to run the elections;
 - b) The next day, hold another meeting to allow each candidate to give campaign speeches. No further campaigning will occur besides reminders that elections will be happening in a week. Coercion or begging by candidates to get votes shall be against the law and punishable by disqualification; voters who do not report coercive candidates will be stripped of voting rights and be tried along with the candidate for conspiracy;
 - c) The next Friday, elections will occur, supervised by the Election Commissioners. Following the tallying of votes on a spreadsheet, the results will be put on the website; and
 - d) The next day, the new Chancellor-elect and Prime Minister will be sworn in by the Emperor.
- 3. Colonial Appointments** Find new leaders for the Western divisions, restart the Navy, and conduct new expeditions each week.
- 4. Cadet Branches Reform** Disband all cadet branches. Remove noble ranks from all non-Senior Line personnel (Brianna, Naomi, John, Constantine) and encourage former cadet branch members to use non-Vasa versions of their cadet branch names, such as Walker or Aviz. Eject any former nobles the Emperor does not wish to remain on the Court from the Court, merge the Supreme War Council with the Court, and invite any other trusted advisors the Emperor wishes to be on the Court.
- 5. Provinces** Reform the Provinces to be under direct Crown control following the above reforms stated

in #3. Retool the Provinces into being used as regional names for administrative purposes, and disband the Garrison system; thereby making divisions more mobile

6. Martial Affairs

Utilize the Modern Army Act to its full extent. Specialise trainings according to the new handbooks, and use members of Life Guards divisions as guards for members of the Crown. Reintroduce the salute code, and transition from the old uniform system to the new uniform system in February. Make sure all division leaders are Majors and are active and capable, and all Corps guilds are led by active, capable Field Marshals. Any inactive former military officers should be given the rank of Colonel to serve as advisors.
