An Act relating to the Creation of Government-Funded Pensions.

- 1. Short Title** This Act shall be known as the *Pensions Act of 302 AS* in short.
- 2. Introduction** His Imperial Majesty's Government has long since had the desire to establish a pension for the hardworking civil servants and military members of the New Sarovian Empire. Under the government of the Caps, the Ministry of Finance has established two pensions for members of the New Sarovian Empire to utilise: the civil pension and the Armed Forces pension (AFP). These pensions shall place a hard cap on the salaries of civil servants and members of the armed forces in exchange for life-long Saro support for continuous service. These Saros, as per the Currency Act of 2020, can be directly exchanged for Gralats on GraalOnline Classic. Pensions shall be available to all who fit the eligibility requirements, regardless if they remain in the New Sarovian Empire actively or not; these pensions shall not be revoked or removed. A pension may only be legally removed from an individual if they are found guilty and convicted of a serious crime under the Mathiveas Code of Law.

- 3. Civil Pension** The Civil Pension is given to all members of the Civil Service of the Imperial Government who serve for a period of six months or more continuously with no gaps. The pension shall encourage and incentivize citizens of the New Sarovian Empire to work for the Government in various civil positions, such as clerks, ambassadors or other.

In order to qualify for a Civil Service pension, one must meet the following criteria:

- a) You must possess a named position listed in the Civil Services Act of 2023;
- b) You must not currently possess an Imperial Armed Forces pension, or relinquish it; and
- c) You must prove a record of working for the Civil Service for this period of time if asked.

- 4. Martial Pension** The Armed Forces Pension (AFP) is given to all members of the Imperial Army, Navy or other branches decreed by the Crown who serve for a period of 14 months continuously with no gaps. This will include members of the National Service Registry and the Reserve Force, but only for members who routinely show up for duties befitting of a Reservist, such as monthly meetings, calls to arms, or other summons. The pension shall encourage members of the Armed Forces to serve in a variety of staff and field positions for long periods of time.

- a) You must be in the Imperial Army, Navy or other described branch with an official rank higher than the position of Recruit. Time spent as a Recruit shall not count towards your pensionable time;
- b) You must not currently possess a Civil Service pension;
- c) You must prove a record of service for the Imperial Army, navy or other described branch if asked; and
- d) If a Reservist, you must prove attendance at mandatory Army, Navy or other summons with a routine manner.

**5. Pension
Income**

If you qualify for an AFP, you will receive a minimum monthly pension of 800 Saros. If you qualify for a Civil Service pension, you will receive a minimum monthly pension of 800 Saros.
