- 1. Short Title** This Act shall be known as the *Remerra Property Damage Act of 303 AS* in short.
- 2. Introduction** The Imperial Parliament, recognizing that the Boreas Act 2023 empowers the Sarovian Government, specifically the Colonial Secretary, to “govern the Remerra how he/she sees fit” and recognizing, however, that these powers exist within and not above Sarovian constitutional law while simultaneously lamenting the recent outbreak of looting and destruction of property in and around the City of Constantia, acknowledges that, while theft is explicitly prohibited by the Mathiveas Code of Law, property damage is not and believing that decisive action is needed to empower the Sarovian Government to deal with this unacceptable behavior, hereby declares the following provisions.
- 3. Prohibition on Property Damage** The destruction of any property, including the breaking of blocks or placement of destructive items such as fire, lava, or end crystals, owned by a Sarovian citizen without that particular citizen’s consent or the consent of the Colonial Secretary is to be considered an unlawful breach of the peace and, should a case regarding property damage be brought before the Court system, tried as such.
- 4. Prosecution of Property Damage** If evidence is submitted to the Imperial Sarovian Constabulary which the Commissioner of said Constabulary judges to be valid, either the Commissioner or a member of the Constabulary authorized by the Commissioner must approach the affected party or parties and discuss with them on whether they wish to press charges. If charges are to be pressed, the case shall enter the Court system as with any other.
