An Act relating to the Establishment of Public Schools in the Empire and their Wellbeing.

Given Sanction on the 19th of September, 2024

1. Short Title	This Act shall be known as the <i>Public Education Act</i> in short.
2. Preamble	The Public Education Act is hereby enacted to establish a unified system of foundational education throughout New Sarovia, ensuring that all citizens have access to essential knowledge and understanding of Sarovian civics and society and all are brought to a sufficient level of understanding.
	Under this Act, four public schools shall be established, one for each province, jointly administered by both the federal and provincial governments. These schools will provide a standardised curriculum that emphasises the fundamental principles of Sarovian governance, law, history, culture and civic responsibility, cultivating a well-informed and loyal citizenry.
	By imparting these essential elements of civic education, the Act aims to foster a sense of national unity, shared values, and allegiance to the Empire. The creation of these schools is a critical step in strengthening the social fabric and future of Sarovia, ensuring that all citizens, regardless of background or status, understand their rights, duties, and the foundational principles that guide our nation. The collaboration between federal and provincial authorities in administering these schools is intended to promote local involvement while maintaining a cohesive national standard of education.
3. Identity of the Schools	These four schools shall be known as:
	 a) Cuive Public School (CPS); b) Upper Preuze Public School (UPPS); c) Preuze Public School (PPS); and d) Vurgos Public School (VPS).
	Each school shall be created as a channel in each provincial category, to be seen by all, with addition to a private School Board channel. Members of the Legislative Assemblies shall be authorised and mandated, under penalty of breaching the Sarovian Identity Act, to be teaching classes under the personal direction of the Ministry of Education as part of the board, and furthermore, one local member of the Stefanic Clergy is mandated to serve on the Public School Board. The Minister of Education and all provincial government liaisons will also have access.
4. Teaching Content	The content to be taught in all public schools revolves around an informal six to seven day program, which may be taught as frequently as possible. The curriculum of this program shall be mandated by directions from the Ministry of Education, but fall under the following six to seven categories which shall act as the informal daily program:
	a) Sarovian citizenship, how to gain it (which shall be part of the graduating requirements), and the basics of High Sarovian;

- b) Sarovian civics, including provincial and federal parliaments;
- c) Sarholm, including a scheduled in-game tour for all students;
- d) The wider Empire, including a rudimentary history of New Sarovia;
- e) The Sarovian economy, including Saros, Liras, etc;
- f) The Stefanic faith, including the adoption of a HS name and being baptised by the Church, to be taught by the Stefanic clergy; and
- g) An optional day for the province to teach details about their province, including culture, holidays, structure, laws, community, etc;

No class may be skipped or opted out of except for the Stefanic class, only to be opted out in the manner of the values of Stefanism directly conflicting with genuine religious beliefs, which under no circumstances may be infringed by the Sarovian government. Classes shall be taught via Discord, with mandatory reactions and input from students to pass each day, but additional classes may be taught in Estos should teachers and students both agree and consent.

5. Graduation Upon finishing all 6-7 days of the Public School, Sarovians are mandated to take the Sarovian citizenship form. After proof of application, students are then mandated to pass a 15 question multiple choice exam, directly given by an instructor through Discord DMs. The Ministry of Education will provide 30 questions, of which 15 will remain a backup series of questions in the event of suspected cheating. The instructor will screenshot the answers and provide proof to the Minister of Education, in which the answers of the person shall not be shown as "edited" in any way lest their test be invalidated.

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
